

BMW'S PREFIELD PROCESS

Biblical Ministries Worldwide is dedicated to helping North American churches fulfill their mission of spreading the gospel and planting churches in gospel-deprived locations around the world.

We do this largely by taking the finest servant-leaders offered to us by these local churches and equipping them for cross-cultural ministry. This involves a four-step process (start at the bottom).

4 Six months later (July), if your deputation is drawing to a close, you will come back to BMW for your final two weeks of training at the **Field Prep Seminar**. We'll examine church-planting more in-depth, worldviews, apologetics, ethics, teamwork issues, culture shock, adjusting as a family, handling finances from overseas, etc. From there, you prepare to leave for the field.

3 Six months later (January), you will come back to BMW for another week of **ReL8** cross-cultural competency training and Good Soil Evangelism and Discipleship training. After six months of traveling, raising support, and working on your **Personal Development Plan**, the time together will encourage and inspire you.

2 You'll begin your training at BMW by spending two weeks with us in July for the **Candidate Seminar**. It's a time for us to get to know you, and for you to learn about missions and the purpose, values, vision, and people that make BMW tick. You will likely be welcomed into the BMW family at this point and be trained in enlisting ministry partners.

1 To start your journey with BMW, send in the **Preliminary Questionnaire**. After receiving your church's recommendation, we will send you an **Application Packet** and conduct some initial assessments.
